Acute painful cerebrovascular syndromes are a frequent emergency department presentation with potentially devastating sequelae. A basic understanding of the syndromes is crucial for their timely identification, and prompt and adequate referral for their appropriate management – including consultation with a neurological service.

This session aims to increase understanding of these life threatening conditions and will outline the critical role of a GP in referral to an emergency department and in increasing community awareness.

Discussion points include:

- differential diagnoses of acute focal neurological deficits due to vascular lesions presenting with headache
- identification of acute painful cerebrovascular syndromes - caveats and limitations
- prognosis and long-term management.
