Prostate Cancer is not a simple disease. It takes many forms and can affect men of different ages and walks of life. Sometimes it advances quickly, other times slowly. Sometimes men experience symptoms, often they do not. It is the most commonly diagnosed cancer in Australia, and together with New Zealand, we have the highest incidence.

This week 385 men will be told they have it. Tragically, 63 will die from it. One of our goals is the early identification of men who are at risk of prostate cancer. If we can identify men at risk, we can monitor their health and track any changes. Then, if prostate cancer does develop we can detect and treat it at an early stage, ensuring the best possible outcomes.

This session aims to increase the understanding of the latest forms of diagnosis and management options for local and advanced prostate cancer, to ensure accurate diagnosis, timely therapy, and improved patient outcomes. Management and resource guidelines will be provided.
